General Rules and Information

General rules govern each class. Class rules take precedence over general rules.

Interpretation of all rules will be made by the organizers of the SABN Alpaca Art & Fibre Fair committee and the judge. In all cases the right is reserved to entirely reject, or conditionally accept any entry or application.

1. By submitting an entry an exhibitor agrees to the rules set forth in this prize book.
2. Completed Entry forms must be received by Thursday October 15, 2018. Please be sure to have your completed entry form and your entry fee (**cash or cheque payable to SABN**) attached to each item. If mailing entries please let Rachel Vos know at ratchet_16@hotmail.com so its expected and mail prior to October 15, 2018 to:

3. All Entry fees are due when entries are submitted. Entries will not be considered entered in the competition until entry fees are paid.
4. Attach your entry form to your item.
5. The SABN Fibre Committee reserves the right to combine or split classes according to the number of entries.
6. Exhibits that have been incorrectly entered may at the discretion of the judge or committee be transferred to the appropriate class prior to judging. If such classes have been judged they shall not be judged again.
7. Exhibits competing for prizes must be the work of the exhibitor **and must have been completed within the past 24 months.**
8. All winning exhibits will be displayed at the Lloydminster Alpaca Showcase and must remain on display for the entire Show. All exhibits will also be put on display at the Exhibition for the duration of the Show. “Best of Show” and “People’s Choice” winners will be selected from all entries.
9. **ALL EXHIBITS MUST BE PICKED UP BY 3 p.m ON SUNDAY October 21, 2018.** If you cannot pick up your entry – you will be required to make alternate arrangements to have your entries picked up by someone else OR include return postage and shipping instructions to have it shipped home.
10. A judge will be appointed by the SABN Fibre Committee to judge entries in accordance with the criteria on the judging form. Names of the entrants will be withheld from the judge(s). Judges decision will be final. Judging will occur the morning of October 20, 2018 in conjunction with the Lloydminster Alpaca Showcase at the Lloydminster Exhibition Grounds. Winners will be announced at the show and displayed accordingly.

Fibre Fair Rules and Regulations

Please read General Rules.

Eligibility:

The Fibre Challenge is open to all Fibre Artisans. Judge(s), and their immediate families are not eligible to enter.

ALL ENTRIES MUST CONTAIN ALPACA FIBRE OR IMAGE.

Participants are encouraged to enter as many items as they wish that have been completed within the past 24 months.

Competition Categories:

1. Individual Artisan
2. Mill/Commercial
3. Guild
4. Youth
 - A. 10 years of age and under
 - B. 11-16 years of age

Fees:

A \$5.00 entry fee must accompany each entry at the time of submission into the artisan and guild categories.

A \$2.00 entry fee must accompany each entry at the time of submission into the youth categories.

A maximum entry fee of \$20 (\$8 for youth) for which you may enter as many classes as you want.

Prizes:

In all classes, ribbons will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth place.

Best in Show and People's Choice winners will be selected from each class. Best of Show will be selected by the judge while the People's Choice Award will be selected by show participants and attendees.
