**Questions to ask Agribtion:**

- Can we have show in 2020

**Fleece show:**

- Can Carol bring the fleeces when she comes to the barn boss meeting that is held a couple weeks before agribtion and store them in the room? If not then she will make it work to bring fleeces on Saturday
- Can we come on Saturday to get fleeces ready for compition – Carol's alpacas will come that day as well – all other alpacas would come on sunday
- Judge will judge fleece show on Sunday and finish Monday morning
- Do a fleece presentation Monday at 1pm in show ring
- The fleece judging area will need 6 tables – after we are done with them for the judging can we use them to present the fleeces to the public
- Where would these tables go – three in front and three behind
- Don't forget we need to do the online registration stuff and also order the ribbons
- Signage – we want to explain what the judge is judging on – maybe hang?
- Fleece show fee is normally \$40 – I can't remember what you said you would keep and we would get - what is that amount
- Do you allow shows to have prize money?

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**Halter show:**

- Signage – we want signage that explains what a judge is looking for – maybe can we hang cause there is so many people
- If we were to get a longer show ring – then on tues night we could make the show ring smaller for the sheep and set up more pens?? Not sure if that's allowed
- Can we have a pen of pet alpacas by the goat pen so the school kids could see them easier – also would you like this pen to stay all week – I could try it
- The announcer table should be on the other side of the show ring – I hated having my back to everyone walking up
- We are going to try RV matts for our pens – we have purchased 12 of them – we think wood chips to go under – but we are still debating - do we purchase wood chips the same as straw bales?
- We don't need a scale or wash area
- We still get \$20 per entry fee for halter show – that's what it was last year
- Can we have an obstials set up in showring for Monday – how will we do that with public?
- Whoever is in charge of the education paper that the school kids get – can they change the llama to an alpaca?
- Can we do an alpaca 101 presentation again – last year we had about 60 to 70 people attend
- I would like if judge could do a presentation to the alpaca breeders present for about an hour on Monday in afternoon
- Beef and barley event – can you tell me more so I know what to tell my people
- For the pet stock is that ok if they are not registered in the show
- Talk to woody about an Agribition show sign?
- What time can I release exhibitors on tues – I can't remember
- Things we absolutely loved – security, show program no mistakes incredible, show on line registration, the penning was awesome, media was amazing, all the interest, the CWA team was very accomidated,
